As part of the submission process, authors are required to check off their submission's compliance with all of the following items, and submissions may be returned to authors that do not adhere to these guidelines.

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

Homoeo Tarang will consider submissions which are original, have not been published in any medium and have not been submitted for publication elsewhere. Submissions derived from presentations at scientific meetings may be considered for publication even when they have been included in proceedings; author(s) must make an explicit statement on this regard.

Homoeo Tarang is entitled to make alterations in submissions to adequate them to the journal's standards, while keeping their style and contents.

Author(s) automatically agree with Homoeo Tarang policies from the moment of the initial submission.

All papers submitted to Homoeo Tarang will undergo peer-review process and will be reviewed by the concerned experts. The comments of the reviewers shall be conveyed to the authors for compliance/ comments. All accepted papers will be suitably edited before publication. However, the decision of the Editorial Board of Homoeo Tarang regarding the publication of the article(s) or any other matter related to JHU is final.

### SUBMISSION RULES:

HOMOEIO TARANG is following the Guidelines suggested by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE); it is recommended to consult them. ([www.icmje.org](http://www.icmje.org))

Submissions will be sent in English (American and British); author(s) are responsible for English grammar; it is recommended to consult an English native speaker or professional translator before making a submission..

#### PARTS OF SUBMISSION:

1. FRONT PAGE: Times New Roman 12; double space; none justified; none indented, containing:

- Journal Section
- Title of submission: must be self-explanatory and accurately represent the submission contents.
- For each author: full name; citation name; highest professional/academic degree; institutional affiliation (name of institution, city, country, website); e-mail; homepage; link to curriculum vitae. Authors must be listed in the final order in which they will appear in the published article.
- Name of corresponding author
- Abstract: must be structured whenever applicable (Background of research project; Aims; Methodology; Results; Conclusions); when not applicable, abstract must give thorough account of the same items. Abstracts must be 150-250 words long.
- Keywords: 3-5 words that best describe the submission contents
- Statement of conflict of interest: authors must declare whether there is conflict of interest and its reason; when there is not conflict of interest must declare “author(s) declare(s) there is no conflict of interest”
- Statement of financial support: author(s) must declare funds related to any step of research and elaboration of submission; when there is no funding, author(s) must declare “author(s) declare(s) that this study received no funding”. If the research has financial support the Author(s) must declare : “ I (We) had full access to all the data in this study and I (We) take complete responsibility for the integrity of the data and the accuracy of the data analysis”

2. MAIN TEXT: Times New Roman 12; single space; non justified; no indentation; no hyphenation, uploaded in Step 3 of submission process, blinded and named “Main Text”, containing:
