

“HOMOEOPATHIC SCIENCE CONGRESS SOCIETY”

AIMS & OBJECTIVE

- a- To Advance and promote the cause of Homoeopathic Science in India and Abroad.
- b- To hold an Annual Congress at a suitable place in India and abroad.
- c- To conduct training and continued medical education in Homoeopathy and allied subjects for the development of professionals.
- d- To publish such proceedings, journals, transactions and other publications as may be considered desirable.
- e- To run a development programme for the welfare of Homoeopathic doctors and create a fund for unforeseen conditions.
- f- To run, manage and maintain health facilities in the rural and urban areas of the society and for this purpose Health care centers and organized eye camps, vaccination camps, pulse and polio drop distribution centers, family planning centers, leprosy centers and give knowledge about AIDS, Cancer, T.B. and Kalazar control programmes and other medical related camps.
- g- To secure and manage funds and endowments for the promotion of Homoeopathic Science including the rights of disposing of, or selling all or any portion of the properties of the Association.
- h- To do and perform any or all other acts, matters and things as are conducive to or incidental to, or necessary for, the above objects.
- i- To provide relief measures among the society during natural calamities like flood, fire, famine, earthquake, cyclone, and drought and provide medicine, food, safe drinking water, sanitation facilities and arrange rehabilitation to the affected people.
- j- To establish institutions like academic colleges, hospitals and health care centers.
- k- To conduct research in medicine specially in the Homoeopathic system of medicines.

TYPES OF MEMBER

Membership of the Congress shall be open to all persons with graduate or more or equivalent academic qualifications in Homoeopathy, interested in the advancement of Homoeopathic science in general, and who shall pay annual subscription as decided from time to time by the General body of the society. The Annual subscription of a member shall become due on the 1st April of each year. Any one, whose subscription does not reach the office on or before the 15th July in any year, shall lose the right of voting and/or holding any office of the Congress for the year. A member failing to pay the annual subscription by the end of March following shall cease to be a member.

A person desirous of joining the society shall apply in writing on a prescribed form to the Secretary General of the Managing Committee who shall forward the same to the Managing Committee and shall be entitled to reject or accept the same without assigning any reason thereof.

TYPES OF MEMBER

INSTITUTIONAL MEMBER: An Institution paying a subscription as stipulated by the Association from time to time, shall be eligible to nominate one person as its representative to attend the Annual Session of the Science Congress. An Institutional Member shall be eligible to receive, free of cost, a

copy of the complete set of Proceedings of the Annual Science Congress Session as also a copy each of the Association's journal, Everyman's Science.

INDIVIDUAL MEMBER: A person paying the prescribed donation and possessing necessary academic qualification as in the case of a Member, shall be an individual Donor of the Association. He shall have all rights and privileges of a Member during one calendar year renewable yearly basis.

LIFE MEMBERS A person paying the prescribed donation and possessing necessary academic qualification as in the case of a Member, shall be an individual Donor of the Association. He shall have all rights and privileges of a Member during his life time

RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES

A Member of the Association shall have the following rights and privileges-

(A) To contribute papers for presentation at the Session of the Congress.

(B) To receive free of charge, the usual publications issued by the Association for the Session. A Member shall also be entitled to purchase other priced publications at a concessional rate.

(c) To participate in all such activities of the society decided by the Executive Committee for them.

APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION AS MEMBER:

A. Every application for the admission as member of the society shall be addressed to the Secretary General of the society

B. No application shall be considered unless the applicant is proposed by a member and seconded by another such member.

C. Every such application shall be considered in the meeting of the Managing Committee and shall be accepted or rejected by a vote of majority save as those failing under rule -4 of these rules.

D. Every applicant shall be informed in writing by the secretary about the decision of the Managing committee which shall be final.
